Washington State “Food For Families” Program

- “Food For Families” is a Supreme Council Program that was initiated in November 2009
- Encourages each jurisdiction in the United States and Canada to work with their local parish churches and other public places to collect food for food banks in their area



How to participate....

- Collect food for local food bank
 - *Sponsor single or multiple food drive*
 - *Ongoing council program or relation with a food bank*



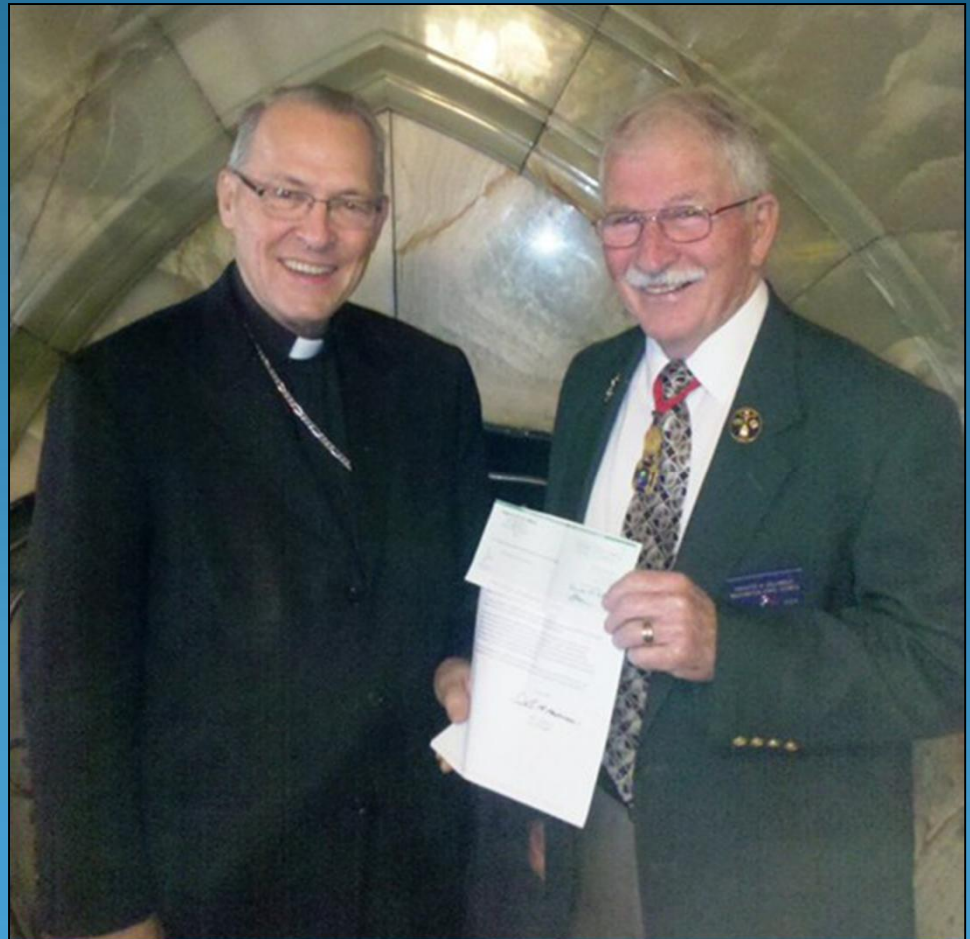
How to Participate...

- Volunteer in local soup kitchens
 - *Single or multiple preparations of food at a soup kitchen*
 - *Ongoing council program or relation with a soup kitchen*



How do we benefit...

- All we need is 25% of our Councils (about 40 Councils) to participate
- If we do that, we receive our portion of \$1,000,000 from Supreme for the food banks in our area!!!!
- This past year, we received ~\$31,000 from Supreme for participating
