Silver Rose 2022: Guidance and Final Routes

Council Resources

Ordering Resources

Each jurisdiction should order supplies at the beginning of the route. Supplies, especially prayer booklets, should be passed from council to council to conserve resources.

The following officers can order prayer booklets and other resources for the program on Supplies Online: state deputies, state executive secretaries, state program directors, state faith directors, grand knights, financial secretaries and council program directors.

Jurisdictional Silver Rose Chairman Guidelines

Transferring the rose to/from another jurisdiction

- Starting in December, the list of routes for 2022 can be found at kofc.org/rose.
- Arrange to receive the rose from the preceding jurisdiction using the dates and contact information provided by Supreme. If your jurisdiction cannot make an in-person transfer, you can ship the rose.
- If your jurisdiction is the first of the route, Supreme will send the rose to you. If your jurisdiction is the last route, Supreme will send shipping labels to your attention to return the rose to Supreme Headquarters for cleaning and repairs.
- If making an in-person transfer, arrange events such as a Silver Rose Prayer Service and/or a Mass in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe. On hand to receive the rose could be the state deputy or his designee, such as the silver rose chairman.
- Fourth Degree participation is crucial to the success of the Silver Rose program. Vice supreme masters should be present at the first event as well as at the closing ceremony. Fourth Degree Honor Guard/Color Corps involvement should begin with the first jurisdiction to carry the rose.
- Keep the state public relations chairman fully apprised of all details so he can issue media alerts to the appropriate newspapers, radio stations and television stations. Ask him to arrange for photography and/or video coverage at the transfer.

Running routes in your jurisdiction

- Promote the silver rose program to councils by highlighting its rosary-centric nature, the story of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the importance of the pro-life cause. A 60-minute video on the history of Our Lady of Guadalupe is available for purchase [here](#).
- Provide links to important resources to councils, especially the Silver Rose Prayer Service Booklet (#4841) which includes a history of the program and the Silver Rose Guidesheet (#10625).
- Ensure your jurisdiction has enough prayer service booklets for your route. Booklets should be returned and provided with the rose to the next host council. Prayer cards (#9754) can be ordered and used by each host council or ordered in bulk at the start of the route and passed along.
- Work with district deputies, grand knights, and council life directors to establish a route that will carry the rose through the jurisdiction within the specified time limit. Using an online sign-up platform and listing available dates works well for this purpose. The Silver Rose schedule form (#10720) provides an example of a schedule you can use to plan your jurisdiction's route.
- Each stopping point along the established route should arrange a Silver Rose Prayer Service. Encourage participating assemblies and councils to contact their pastors far in advance to make arrangements.
- Vice supreme masters should coordinate the participation of district masters and assembly members along the prayer route. Fourth Degree Honor Guard/Color Corps involvement should be visible at all arrivals, Masses, prayer services and welcoming ceremonies.
- Councils can host virtual silver rose prayer services or rosaries at their local parish. You can also allow individual families or council members to host the rose at their home to pray privately or to host a virtual family or council prayer night.
