Archbishop Cupich Celebrates His Final Mass at the Cathedral

On Sunday, November 2nd, Archbishop Blase Cupich celebrated his final Mass at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Lourdes. Culminating a four-year assignment as the Bishop of the Diocese of Spokane, the Archbishop will be leaving Spokane to assume his new posting as the leader of the Archdiocese of Chicago

At the end of Mass, Mary Haugen, President of the Parish Council, presented a \$500 gift certificate to Morton's Steak House in Chicago, as a nod to the Archbishop's upbringing in the Midwest, known for fine steaks. Following that, Father Darrin Connall, Rector of the Cathedral presented a check for \$4000 for the Archbishop to continue his ministry of feeding the poor when he assumes his new position in Chicago.



While acknowledging there is still work to be done that was started during his tenure in Spokane, Archbishop Cupich thanked all those who supported him during his time here. At both the All Souls Mass at Holy Cross Cemetery on Saturday, November 1st and at the Mass at the Cathedral on November 2nd, the Archbishop graciously took the time to recognize the Knights of Columbus for their support, as well as greeting each of us individually following the services to thank us and shake our hands.

The public is invited to a "drop-in" Diocesan Farewell Reception in honor of Archbishop Cupich at St. Peter Parish Hall (3520 E. 18th Avenue, Spokane) on Thursday, November 6th from 2pm-4pm. Light refreshments will be provided. The Archbishop is expected to depart Spokane shortly thereafter, and will reside at the Holy Name Cathedral Rectory in Chicago.

One of the questions came up during one of our visits with Archbishop Cupich this weekend was “Has he been formally installed as an Archbishop? And if so, how do I address him?”

After doing some internet research, he is presently listed as “Archbishop-Designate” on the Archdiocese of Chicago website, a title that will change shortly when he assumes his new position from retiring Francis Cardinal George. While he prefers to be addressed as “Archbishop Cupich”, the proper greeting for his new office would normally be “Your Grace”.

In addition to the above, you can add many riders to these policies. Policies over \$50,000 have a Terminal Illness Rider (Accelerated Death Benefit Rider) at no additional cost. At \$100,000 they include the Chronic Illness Rider (Long term Care Rider for Nursing Home) at no additional cost. You can also add the Single Deposit Paid Up Additions Rider and the Modal Deposit Paid Up Additions Rider to considerably enhance cash values.
